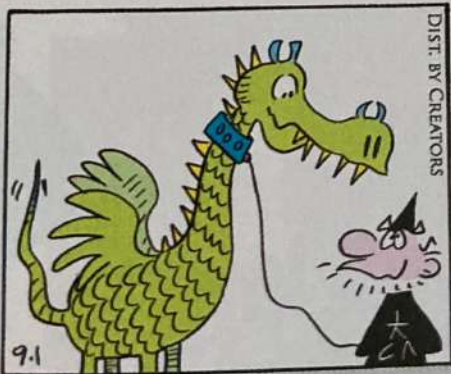

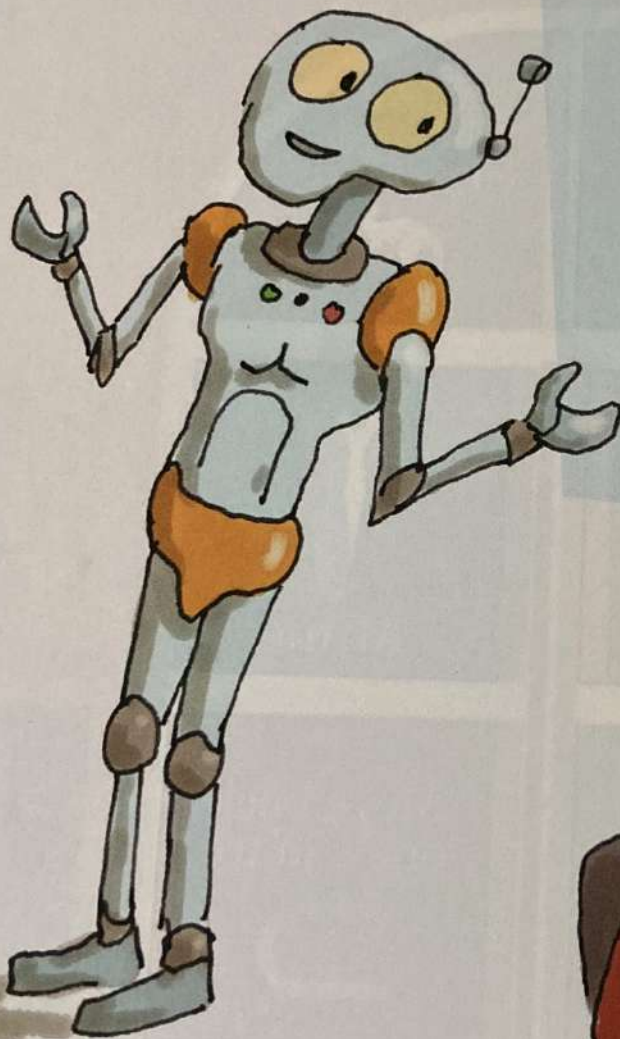

a poem by Jane Yolen

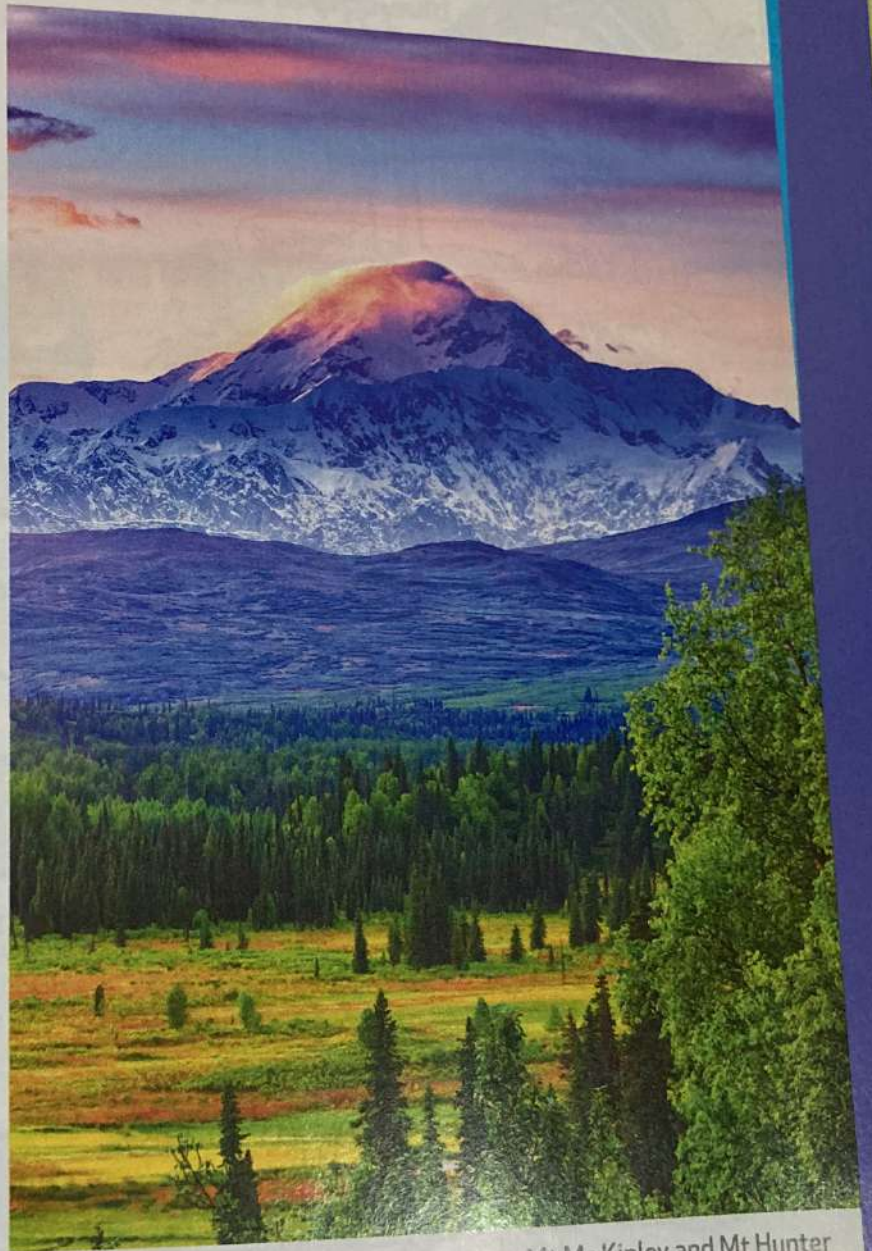
